Request for Information under the Official Information Act 1982 Our Ref: OIA353/1

- 1. We refer to your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (**OIA**) received on 29 April 2022 about Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Figures.
- 2. Please find our responses to your specific questions as below.
- 3. "How many FTE staff in total were employed by your organisation as at 31 December 2021?"
 - Crown Law had a total of 211.5 FTE as at 31 December 2021
- 4. "What percentage of FTE staff in your organisation were earning a salary of \$100,000 or more as at 31 December 2021?"
 - Of the total FTE noted above, 46.5 percent has a base salary of \$100,000.00 or more as at 31 December 2021.
- 5. "How many FTE staff were employed by your organisation for the COVID-19 Response as at 31 December 2021, if any, and how many of these roles are permanent?"
 - Crown Law did not hire any additional staff that had the intention of being dedicated to the support of the COVID-19 response.
- 6. "As of today's date, how many square meters of office space does your organisation have in total?"

Crown Law subleases 3080.5 square meters in the Justice Centre in Wellington

- 2851 square meters of dedicated space
- 229.5 square meters of space shared with MOJ

We also sublease 114 square meters from Serious Fraud office at 188 Quay Steet in Auckland
