Official information request for health insurance benefits provided to Crown Law staff Our Ref: OIA353/1

- 1. I refer to your official information request dated 10 March 2025 for health insurance benefits provided to Crown Law staff.
- 2. The information you have requested is enclosed.
- 3. "Does your organisation offer any health insurance benefits to your staff, where the agency contributes financially?"
 - No, Crown Law does not offer any health insurance benefits or provide any contributions to any health insurance benefits. However Southern Cross has a Crown Law scheme that all employees at Crown Law can access.
- 4. "Can you summarise what you offer?"
 - While Crown Law does not offer any health insurance benefits, Crown Law staff can receive a group discount for Southern Cross health insurance. The amount of discount depends on the level of cover subscribed to.
- 5. "Can you provide a percentage of staff which have taken up the offer broken out by year from 2014 to present."
 - In terms of taking up the Southern Cross Health Insurance at a discounted rate, Crown Law does not collate or have access to this information and declines this request under section 18(e) of the OIA.
- 6. "If there are factors which may have impacted rates e.g. a new offer, please provide context."
